- Maintain NFS Lands (replaced broken Carsonites, used a chainsaw to cut a path along the boundary, marked trees to indicate the line, updated info at monument corners)

- Made new bearing trees & objects when necessary using a Brunton Compass
- Setup, maintain and use Trimble Survey gear including R8 GNSS System, R10 Receiver, TSC3 & TSC7 controllers with Trimble Access. As well as tripods, bipods, Geo XT, Trimble M3 total station, & Avenza Maps.
- Performed various Cadastral surveys on the PLSS, (Public Land Survey System) Engineering & Right-of-Way surveys including: Retracements, Metes & Bounds, Homestead Entry Surveys, Mineral & Mill Site, & Topographic Surveys.
- Trained Student Conservation Association (SCA) members on how to do maintenance.
- Maintained a clean campsite and work truck weekly.
